

We are happy to announce the 2017 call for our MA Programme **Sociology in European Context (SEC),** Institute of Sociological Studies (ISS), Charles University in Prague.

Entering its fourth year of existence, the MA Programme **Sociology in European Context (SEC)** is now affiliated with the new **Jean Monnet Chair in European Political Sociology,** including a strong core of sociology courses with a European focus, as well as additional events on European issues and debates.

Located in the heart of Europe, the Programme enhances students' sociological understanding of complex and dynamic European societies, within the context of the deep challenges the EU currently faces. Besides theory and methodology, the Programme is focused on the timely topics of international migration, human rights, social movements, civic engagement, European integration and society, capitalist change, democratic change and backlash, forms of critique and contestation, and nationalism.

From the academic year 2017/2018 onwards, students will also have the opportunity to benefit from several newly added courses:

A Constitutional Sociology of Europe; Sociology of European Integration; Sociology of Human Rights; Economic Sociology; Social Change in Contemporary Europe; Medical Anthropology: Illness, Medicine and the Body; Critical Sociology of Sport in Global Context.

The courses are taught by international scholars, actively engaged in the international sociological community and

on-going research. Next to in-depth sociological as well as interdisciplinary understanding of contemporary societies, the Programme deepens students' vital skills and experiences for future careers, within or outside academia. In more practically oriented courses, students are introduced to the basics of applied social research and taught how to write a research project and a paper in English.

The tuition fee for the Programme is  $\epsilon$ 4000 per year. For students from countries with a lower gross national income (GNI) per capita, we offer a scholarship  $\epsilon$ 2000 per year.

The early admissions deadline for academic year 2017/18 is 28 February 2017. The early admissions deadline is strongly recommended for students from non-EU or non-EFTA countries who will need a student visa in order to study in the Czech Republic.

## The regular deadline for academic year 2017/18 is 30 April 2017.
